At HiHo we can guide and support you to receive the best help with your childcare costs from the government.

We are a part of all of the government funding schemes: Tax-Free Childcare, 15 Hour Funding, 30 Hour Funding and also childcare vouchers from outside agencies.

Childcare Voucher Schemes- We accept all of the available childcare voucher schemes, this may be offered through your employer, if they are registered with a scheme.

Tax-Free Childcare- The government will contribute a maximum of £2000 per annum, per child, towards your childcare costs. For further information or to see if you are eligible, please visit <https://www.gov.uk/tax-free-childcare>

15 Hour Funding- This is for eligible children of 2 year olds (meeting other criteria) and for all 3 year olds (Universal). The funding is available the term after their 2nd or 3rd birthday. This offer provides 15 hours of free childcare or early education for 38 weeks, a total of 570 hours per year, or 11.4 hours stretched across 50 weeks.

30 Hour Extended Funding (working parent)for children aged 9 months- 23 months, 2 years and 3 and 4 year olds- This offers 30 hours of free childcare for 38 weeks, a total of up to 1140 hours per year, or 22.8 hours stretched across 50 weeks of the year. The funding is available from the term after they turn 9 months.

Fully Funded Session Options

Option 1: 15 Hours Funding (38 Weeks)

Option 2: 11.4 Hours Funding (50 Weeks)

Session Options:

- Option B: Three sessions per week from 9:00 AM to 12:45 PM

Option 3: 30 Hours Extended Funding (38 Weeks)

Session Time:

- Daily sessions from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM

Option 4: 22.8 Hours Funding (50 Weeks)

Session Time:

- Daily sessions from 8:00 AM to 12:30 PM

Additional Hours: Any extra hours beyond the funded sessions are optional and can be tailored to fit individual family schedules.

Flexibility: We are committed to offering flexible early years education that meets both quality learning standards and the diverse needs of working families.

Please note that this offer is subject to EYFE eligibility and the guidelines outlined in the new EYFE Provider Agreement. For further details or to discuss flexible arrangements, please contact our management team.

Additional Information

We offer optional additional extras- hot lunch/tea, cold tea (£4 per meal) and our Christmas Party.

These are not statutory and parents/carers are welcome to provide their own meals and not attend. If you would like further information on costs, please get in touch. Provision may be met to support families with costing for party.

If a child is eligible for EYPP we will use this to enhance their learning outcomes and experiences with us, e.g. peripatetic sessions, staff training, resources.

As in line with our policy we require 1 month notice to terminate the contract, where families are accessing EYFE only or EYFE which can't be separated from non-funded hours.
